Tournament Rules (Terms & conditions of the league still apply, see website)

- All matches must run to time, no stopping the clock unless a forced cancellation is necessary.
- If a game has to be stopped, the tournament will re-commence from the relevant match for that time, (any matches not played due to stoppages, will be recorded as a drawer or if seen fit, at the discretion of the umpires)
- On hearing the horn sound to end the match, the next team immediately takes the place of the team coming off court. The umpires start the next match without delay on their whistle when players are in place. Players must not delay the start of a match and if not present when the whistle blows, they may take up their position immediately with acknowledgement from the umpires. There will be **No breaks** between matches and **No swapping ends** for the team staying on to avoid wasting time unnecessarily.

Tournament Officials

- **3 umpires** (*Mandy, Deb, Faye*) to share the 2 hours of matches, either together or full court - either give score card to Results Official at end of match or the Results Official can be the scorer then update the results sheet.
- **1 Match Co-ordinator** (Gina) to control teams coming off and going on court on time– ensure the next team have bibs on ready to enter the court on the sound of the horn.
- **1 Time Keeper** (Gina with help from Gwen if needed) to sound the horn at the exact minute – set the alarm to be every 6 mins for first hour until 7.59 then set it for every 5 mins thereafter. The two hours are very tight between matches so it is essential to keep to the minutes precisely without any changes.
- **1 Results Official** (Gwen) to record the results onto the results sheet provided and keep the score cards safe – the scoring system will be **5 points for a win, 3 points for a drawer, 1 point for half or more opponent's score.**

Equipment needed

1 match ball - placed in centre circle when not in play, **Horn, Timer, Pre-set Score Cards, Whistles, pens, 2 x timesheet notices** for display, **bluetack**, 4 x set of **bibs**, **Results Sheet, team benches** around court – placed away from umpires path.
